- All communication of laboratory results must be in English unless otherwise agreed.
- The subject of the Email must indicate the herd owner's name (or quarantine facility) and the CHR number of the herd.
- Any non-specific test reactions must be clarified before the results are communicated to the DVFA.
- If any positive or "false positive" results are found (e.g. as result of tests to verify a possible non-specific reaction), it is the duty of the laboratory immediately to notify the Danish Veterinary and Food Administration via the E- mail: **14@fvst.dk**
